

International Seminar „Poor Neighbours in Europe? Strong Impulses from Bulgaria and Romania?“ 14-22 April, Ruse

Bulgaria and Romania are members of the EU since 2007. Participants from Romania, Germany and Bulgaria will discuss and experience what those two Balkan states being poor countries can bring in the common “European home”. The event will take place between 14 and 22 April 2009 in Ruse. The intergenerational and international group will deal in a creative way with the “strong impulses” from Bulgaria and the results of the project will be then presented before the German public in May when the Bulgarians and Romanians will return the visit to the German participants.



The seminar is organized by the International Elias Canetti Society together with the Academy for Political and Social Education “Haus am Maiberg”, Germany. The two organizations take part in the program “Political Education in Action”, which is initiated by the Foundation Robert Bosch and the Bundescenter for Political Education in Germany.
