

„Should I stay or should I go?: On the reality and the illusions of life abroad”

On the 19th October 2010 in the International Elias Canetti Society centre a discussion took place on the topic „Should I stay or should I go?: On the reality and the illusions of life abroad”. The discussion was dedicated to the International day against human trafficking. Some of the questions which were discussed were:



- 1) Which taxi driver is richer – the one in Berlin or the one in Sofia?
- 2) Which one is the better place to live in – Bordeaux or Ruse?
- 3) Where is it easier to find a job – in Paris or in Plovdiv?
- 4) Where is life happier – in Barcelona or in Varna?
- 5) Who feels more lonely – the average worker in Bulgaria or the one in Spain?
- 6) Who feels more secure – the Bulgarian or the Italian?

The main idea was to give young people the opportunity to share their point of view on life and work abroad, and to ask once again the question “Is life abroad better than life in Bulgaria”.
